Integrated Patient-Centered Care: Through Collaboration with Aetna Better Health of Louisiana


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#### What is Integrated Care?

The *care* that results from a practice team of primary care and behavioral health clinicians and other staff working with patients and families, using a systematic and cost-effective approach to <u>provide patient-centered care</u> for a defined population.





#### Why Integrated Care Is Important

- 1. The relationship between mental and physical health is becoming increasingly supported by research studies and health data
  - Historically these two aspects of the human body were treated separately, but as research shows, <u>behavioral health issues are increasingly accompanied by chronic health conditions</u> that profoundly impact individuals and make them significantly more susceptible to physical health issues
  - ❖ Depression has been linked to many chronic illnesses that include diabetes, asthma, cancer, cardiovascular disease, and arthritis
  - Schizophrenia has also been linked to higher risk of heart and respiratory diseases
- 2. Mental Health conditions can also make dealing with a chronic illness more difficult
  - ❖ The mortality rate from cancer and heart disease is higher among people with depression or other mental health conditions
  - People with mental health diagnoses are more likely to suffer sleep disorders and smoke cigarettes, both contribute to physical ailments
- 3. Research also shows how physical conditions often contribute to mental health symptoms
  - Psoriasis is associated with acute stress and depression
  - Cancer diagnoses and heart attacks can lead to feelings of depression or anxiety

Crisis intervention and stabilization	You can get help right away if you have a mental health emergency or crisis.	
Therapeutic group homes	Allows youth to live in a home-like setting with a small group of other youth to get the services needed.	Covered for members from age 0-20. Prior authorization is required.

60% of your patient's health is driven by social, behavioral, and environmental factors like their education, income, and race/ethnicity

 Social and environmental factors drive health disparities:

<u>Unequitable access</u> to education, employment, healthy environments, and healthcare <u>are driven</u> by structural biases including gender discrimination and racism

 Unmet social needs are associated with higher utilization and cost:

People reporting <u>food insecurity or lack of</u>
<u>transportation</u> are more likely to report **multiple ED visits** and inpatient stays

- The **most important reason** for monitoring each child's development is to find out if a child's development is on track
- ➤ It is **important to act early** if there are signs of potential development delay because early treatment is so important for improving a child's skills and abilities

## Most children with developmental delays are not identified early enough for them to benefit from early intervention services; you can help change that.

- Although about **1 in 6 children** has a developmental disability, <u>less than half</u> of these children are identified as having a problem before starting school.
- ➤ Too often, adults don't recognize the signs of a potential developmental disability, they are not sure if their concern is warranted, or they <u>don't have resources</u> to help make their concern easier to talk about.
- > But **pinpointing concerns and talking** about them is very important to getting a child the help needed.





## **Final Thoughts** All of the topics discussed are important to treating the whole person in a personcentered manner. By monitoring each adult and/or child in your care for behavioral health concerns, social determinants of health, and for children developmental delays you can identify those who might need services and support and help them get it for themselves as early as possible.



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
